

These "At-Home" lessons are intended to add to our Sunday School teachings each Sunday as we go through the Six-Week Pursuit together. You can do them with your preschooler on Sundays as an immediate supplement to our lesson, or throughout the week as a refresher.

There will be one per week.

Week 4 - "Elijah Shows God-given Authority"

Scripture Verse: Elijah...prayed earnestly that no rain would fall, and none fell for three and a half years!" James 5:17

Read Together:

1 Kings 17:1 and 1 Kings 18:43-45.

Say Together:

Elijah ...prayed earnestly (fold hands as in prayer) that no rain would fall, (shake your head no) none fell for three and a half years! (Hold 3 fingers up) James 5:17

Play Together:

Car Time: Look for people of authority, policemen, firemen, mommies, and daddies. Tell your child people of authority are like bosses or take care of people like your mom and dad.

Play Time: Play Simon Says The person who is "it" is the authority and tells the group what to do. Simon Says is a game where "Simon" or the one "it" gives a simple command like hop on one foot or put your hands on your head etc. The one "it" must say "Simon says" before the command or the action should not be done. If someone does the action without "Simon Says", they are out of the game. Play until no one is left. The last one out gets to be Simon.

Pray Together:

Talk about who is in authority in your life, parents, policemen, firemen, etc., and talk about the ultimate authority, Jesus Christ. We love him and want to please

him. Pray with your child for those in authority over you. Also pray that God will help you do what He says because you love him, and he is the ultimate authority.
